Henry Magallanez introduced Chuy Morales and Zachary Libbin who presented the board with permits for the month of February.

Zia Natural Gas Manager Leslie Graham introduced Chad Reynold, Ron Reynold and Arturo Tarango. She spoke to the board regarding the start date beginning April 1, 2011 and at this time they will be doing customer service. Zia Natural Gas is based out of Ruidoso, NM but there local office is located at 300 W. Picacho Ave and will be open by March 28, 2011. She expresses her hope to develop a good working relationship with EBID. An application letter will be presented to the board at the April 13, 2011 board meeting.

Kevin Bixby presented to the board his La Mancha Wet Land Project. The land was donated to Mr. Bixby in 2003 and started working on the project in 2006. Mr. Bixby expresses how he is trying to work with EBID and stake holders. He will connect to the river through a levee already installed and water will only flow if the river is 12 cfs or higher. There are a few issues regarding water right approvals. There are three water right acres so far approved. Wayne Miller calculates nine acft per year with a full allocation. The project is to restore fish in the river and the Leasburg Dam. Mr. Bixby explains to the board they are still working on how to measure water deliveries; and it seems that the best way that works so far is the way EBID measures the water. Samantha Barncastle adds that IBWC has said they will not work with Mr. Bixby until they have spoken with EBID first. Henry Magallanez asked if he still had funding available. Kevin Bixby explained he was awarded two grants one in 2008 and the other in 2010. The 2010 grant contract has not yet been recieved. He is hoping to receive that grant before the irrigation season.

Gary Esslinger advised the board that Leo Barrett would not be in to give his Maintenance report due to an issue that came up with the IBWC contractors hitting a gas line and traffic being blocked on the levee. EBID has been working with the local contractors and have not had any problems with them.

Richard Bejarano introduced Roman Ramos the new Assistant Watermaster. Roman spoke to the board and expressed his gratitude and is looking forward to improving the districts efficiency. Richard Bejarano updated the board on the Watermaster meeting. EP #1 small track schedule is April 8, 9 and 10<sup>th</sup>. Richard explains no burning has started due to lack of permission. He does state the farmers have been burning and doesn't see how they have been given the ok and yet EBID is unable to. Gary Esslinger asked Delyce Maciel if this is occurring. Delyce explains that it is the city dispatch that lets you know if there is no burning allowed; she advises the board she will be checking more often.

Dr. Phil King presented to the board his presentation for the EBID Growers Meeting. He reiterates to the board that is going to be a short year due to lack of snow run off. If the relinquishment becomes immediately it will not affect us negatively for next year. There will be a allocation meeting March 10, 2011. Dr. King recommends asking for a one hundred thousand acft relinquishment. Motion to request relinquishment by Jerry Franzoy second by Robert Sloan. Motion Carried. Dr. King states a May irrigation season may happen if EBID is awarded the relinquishment. He explains to the board a six inch allotment is equal to one flat rate weekend.

Chris Canavan spoke to the board on water quality testing and standards. He advises the board there are currently nine water quality stations in lower Rio Grande. In a 2004 survey they used to check and see state and local water quality standards. The Tierra Blanca Creek was added this year. Assessment units are significant to look at. Two assessment units came back with ecoli. Gary Esslinger asked Mr. Canavan if during the testing they noticed a spike in the Sunland Park area, and if there is some one appointed to check if there are wastes being dumped in the area. Chris Canavan's response was no and he was not sure who would be responsible for that area but did advise that he would look into it.

Valerie Beversdorf gave her update on fusion. She lets the board known Dave Nelson has been in the EBID offices working on fusion for water records to be ready for the 2011 irrigation season. Work is on going to with units to fill in the areas missing for turnouts. Henry Magallanez and James Narvaez are working on well permits.

Gail Norvell presented to the board the financial reports for the Month of February 2011. Cash in the bank is \$777,747, assessments receivable is \$2,111,954 and investments \$8,827,211 for a total increase of \$1,083,457 over February 2010. Grant projects are on going. Gary Esslinger explains to the board that the Water Trust Board Grant Diez Lagos Regulating Reservoir is not final yet. The project was a query of an additional 40 acres by Greg Collins. Gary has tried repeated times to get a hold of Mr. Collins and unfortunately is unable to locate him. Gary will continue to try and locate Mr. Collins or look at other sources so the district does not lose the grant funding.
